

Student Scholarships

For UG /PG students admitted in 2017-18

President Scholarship

Type of Scholarship:

This is a merit-based scholarship available to eligible students.

Eligibility:

It is offered to 1st year UG and PG students in the program under FA, FP, FT, FD and FM admitted in 2017-18

Eligibility is based on Merit.

Merit rank based on CGPA / rank in admission merit list	Eligible Scholarship Amount
Highest merit rank	70% of fees paid
Second highest merit rank	50% of fees paid

Disbursement:

- All eligible applicants will be placed on a program-wise priority list in a descending order of Admission merit Rank (or CGPA during renewal).
- If any scholarship budget is left over, it will be utilized either in the same year for other Student scholarship or will be carried over as emergency scholarship fund, as decided by the scholarship committee.

1	70% of fees paid	4 (1 for each program)	5 (1 for each program)
2	50% of fees paid	4 (1 for each program)	5 (1 for each program)

Renewal:

- Students need to reapply each year for renewal of scholarship.
- Renewal is subject to their merit rank (based on CGPA) at the end of previous semester. (minimum 2.7 CGPA (equivalent of B-))

Suspension / Withdrawal:

- Failure to complete full coursework (min 19 credits per semester) in past 2 semesters will lead to non-renewal of scholarship.
- The scholarship will be withdrawn in case a serious disciplinary or plagiarism charge is proved against the beneficiary student.

How to apply:

Documents:

Only Application Form needed for new applicants.
Result – Grade Report of Previous Academic Record / Mark sheet / Transcript

Committee:

Independent Scholarship Committee (ISC) based on available budget decides the number of scholarship to be awarded in a particular academic year for UG programs
