

## Build your 3D Printer – Two day workshop

Date & Venue: **March 28 & 29, 2015** at FabLab, CEPT University

### Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is this workshop about?**

'Build your 3D Printer' is a 2-day workshop organized by CEPT University where participants will have a hands-on experience on assembling a 3-D printer, along with the supporting software for 3-dimensional printing.

- **Who is eligible to apply?**

The workshop is open for students and professionals alike. Registered students from any full-time undergraduate or masters' course can apply. *Students from distance-learning institutes do not qualify for this course.* Professionals, from any educational background can also apply for this workshop.

- **Who will benefit by attending this workshop?**

Architects, engineers, designers, entrepreneurs and 'makers' will benefit by learning to produce quick 3-D models or prototypes on their own.

- **What are the dates and venue of workshop?**

The workshop will be held on **March 28 & 29, 2015** at FabLab, CEPT University.

- **What is the fee?**

Students will be charged Rs. 6,000 and professionals will be charged Rs. 15,000 for the 2-day workshop; that covers the cost of assembling and testing the 3-D printing machine.

- **Is there a certificate award?**

Each participant who successfully completes the workshop requirements will be awarded with a certificate of participation by CEPT University.

- **How many seats are available?**

A maximum of **20** participants will be enrolled for the workshop. A single printer will be assembled by a group of four participants. However, CEPT University may cancel or move the workshop to different dates as deemed fit.

- **Are there any preferences for selection of participants?**

6 CEPT students and 6 professionals will be given preference for admission. The remaining 8 seats are available for students and professionals as mentioned above.

- **How to apply?**

- **What are the important dates?**

Application deadline: **March 12, 2015**

Declaration of selected participants: **March 16, 2015**

Last date of fees payment: **March 21, 2015**

- **Can the assembled printer be taken away?**

**Three** of the assembled printers could be taken away by any participant by paying additional Rs. 30,000 to cover the cost of materials.

- **Who shall lead the workshop?**

The workshop will be led by a Chennai based organization - CreatorBot (<http://creatorbot.com/>) who work on innovating affordable and high quality digital manufacturing tools ranging from furniture, art, toys to electronic gadgets. These low-cost products enable digital manufacturing a reality for independent designers and entrepreneurs.
