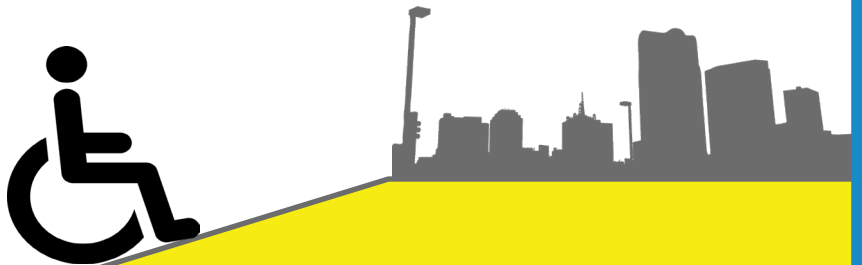

- The buildings will be surveyed and shall be evaluated for the accessibility based on standards and the identified barriers will be looked into to enhance accessibility with a user friendly design.

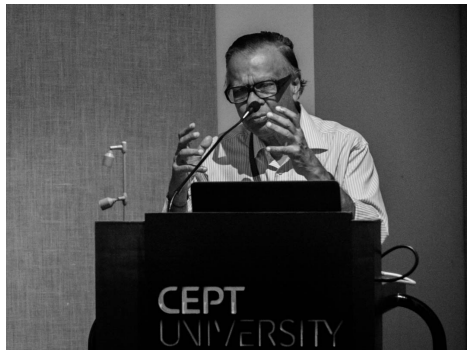
SCOPE OF THE WORK

- Targetting public spaces & institutional building

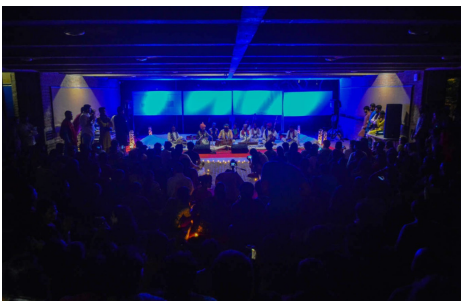
