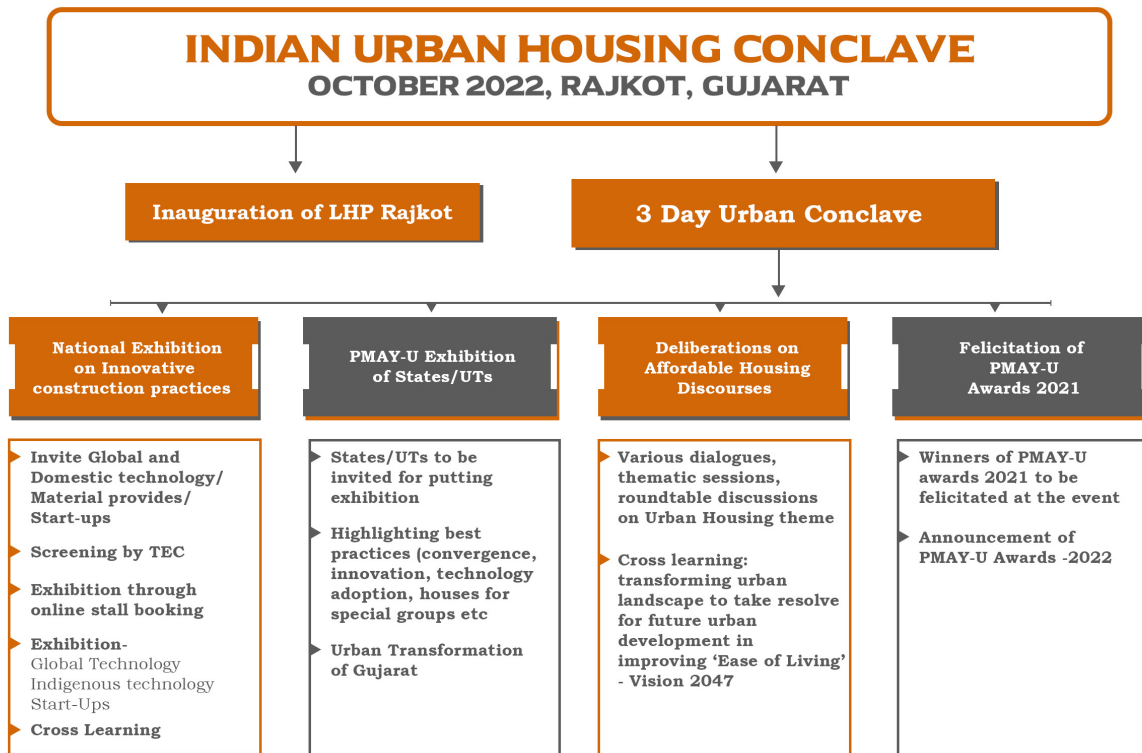


Call for Posters for Indian Urban Housing Conclave, 2022

17th to 19th October 2022 | Last Date: 7th October 2022

CEPT University announces the call for posters from students and young graduates from the fields of architecture, planning, urban design, habitat studies, engineering from all over the country on the topic “Future of Affordable Housing in India”. The call for posters is being jointly organized with the Housing for All Directorate, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India for the Indian Urban Housing Conclave.

Indian Urban Housing Conclave is proposed to be organized in Rajkot from 17th to 19th October 2022. It is proposed that the Conclave will be inaugurated by Hon’ble Prime Minister and will have the following components:



Objective

The objective of the poster competition is to bring out the creative expression of students and to gauge their knowledge and awareness of various trends in Affordable Housing Sector. The aim of the Poster Making Competition is not just to judge the students based on their creative aspects but also to trigger thought process among the students towards recent trends in the field of Affordable Housing in India and its future.



Eligibility

- Participant can be an individual or a group of upto 3 people pursuing a degree in architecture/ planning/ urban design/ habitat studies/ engineering; or
- The participant must have a degree in architecture/ planning/ urban design/ habitat studies/ engineering (Graduated post 2019); or
- Individual who has completed PhD or pursuing PhD or any research work in affordable housing/ urban development/ social sector/ engineering sector can also apply as a participant.

Evaluation Criteria

- Innovative yet realistic concepts
- Relevance to the context
- Originality & Critical thinking
- Effectiveness in Communication
- Good research and presentation skills

Application & Evaluation

Participants should send the soft-copy (in pdf format) of the poster before 7th October 2022 to iuhcposter@gmail.com

- Theme: **Future of Affordable Housing in India**
- Each entry should be of maximum two posters of A0 (841mm x 1189 mm)
- A note explaining the concept of the poster (500 words)
- A brief profile of the applicants (maximum 250 words)

A review Committee comprising of Members from CEPT University, UN Habitat and MoHUA will evaluate all entries and will shortlist 30 top entries. Participants of the top 30 entries will be invited to present their posters to a jury during the IUHC in Rajkot, Gujarat. Top three entries will receive prizes and certificates from MoHUA. All 30 entries will receive certificate of participation from MoHUA.
