## **Guidance for Applicants for New Centers**

- 1. The completed application forms along with CVs and photographs are to be e-mailed to **crdf@cept.ac.in** on or before **30 September 2018**.
- 2. Shortlisted candidates will be advised by e-mail only on or before **30 October 2018.**
- 3. The form is intended to convey your message in a simple manner and applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of the form.
- 4. Please stay within the word limit stated on the Application Form.
- 5. At present, the intention is to start two new Centers, in addition to the Centers on Noise Pollution and Acoustics and Textiles in construction.
- 6. The form is to be used for all new Center proposals including the two named above
- 7. Forms are to be filled in English and can be typed in size 10 font or legibly handwritten.
- 8. At this stage, please do not submit any additional information with the exception of your CV, which shall be no longer than 2 sides of A4.
- 9. The applications must be domain focused and based around a theme. We will look for creativity, innovation, simplicity of ideas, practical application of ideas, clarity of vision etc.
- 10. Applications will be judged on the basis of the following...
  - · Quality of ideas
  - Organisation skills and clarity of vision
  - Economic and environmental Sustainability and ability to attract funding
  - Application to the urban environment and benefit to society
  - Leadership and management qualities of individuals promoting new Centers along with their commitment
- 11. There is no application fee.
- 12. Shortlisted candidates will be required to make a power-point presentation for 30 minutes with no more than 20 slides.
- 13. Should you wish to adopt any other method of show and tell, this is also acceptable provided you complete your talk in 30 minutes.
- 14. Should you be selected to start a Center, you must do so within 45 days of being notified.
- 15. Should you be selected to start a Center, you will need to sign an Agreement with CRDF and unconditionally comply with all operational, financial and reporting requirements.
- 16. Intellectual Property rights emanating from any work carried out by the Centers shall belong to CRDF and CEPT University.
