CEPT University Anti-Ragging Policy

The university community knows the prevention and prohibition of ragging in institutions imparting higher education in the country is a great concern and should be taken seriously.

The punishment meted out must act as a deterrent against the recurrence of such incidents. All efforts should be made to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on a priority basis to send the message that ragging is not only to be discouraged but also to be dealt with sternly.

It is emphasized in the student and parent declaration that ragging of and among students in this university in any form at any place will not be tolerated. The student and parent orientation at the start of every semester reiterates the same. All the students and their parents/guardians shall submit an undertaking in the prescribed form at the beginning of the academic session itself, failing which the student concerned will not be allowed to register for the semester.

CEPT University has an Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squads, details of which are available on the website and on the notice boards.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the University, the University shall level punishment be any one or a combination of the following:

- Community service
- Suspension from attending classes/semester
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, or festival.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Expulsion from the institution if need be
- Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
